Introduction

The pilot testing of the e-learning course for workplace language and communication for nurses will be carried out in all partner countries – France, Italy, Netherlands, Spain, Romania and Bulgaria in the period 25.07. – 07.09.2018. The whole course (all 6 units) should be tested in each country, irrespectively of the language.

The main objective is to collect feedback from target group representatives and language specialists about the developed e-learning course with respect to the training content and methodology and based on the results to improve the course, if needed. In order to achieve this objective, the participants will be involved in the following activities:

- Piloting workshops (E1 – E6);
- Individual work with the course – each participant will have to test at least 2 units of the course;
- Filling in evaluation questionnaires.

The scope of the feedback that will be collected will cover the following issues:

- *Training content* – appropriateness of topics covered considering the real work situations the nurses are involved in, easy to understand, meeting the expectations of nurses, useful for improvement of their language and communication skills (spoken and written interaction in the work situations covered by the course);
- *Tests/activities* – correspondence between the content and the tasks the trainee has to fulfil, providing support to the learning process;
- *Hints* – comprehensiveness, adequacy, understandable, supporting learning process;
- *e-learning system* – easy for navigation, appropriate structure and design, interactivity.

This document provides guidelines to partners with respect to organization and conducting of the pilot workshops, the support to be provided to participants during the individual testing of the course, as well as the evaluation questionnaires and the template for reporting the results obtained at national level.

1. Participants in the pilot testing and evaluation

In each country at least 15 nurses and trainers in French, Italian and/ or Dutch language should be involved. The nurses (local, who plan to work abroad or foreign ones) have to know the respective language at level A2 or B1, according to their self-assessment or holding a certificate, since these are the entry levels for the course. It is recommendable the language trainers to have experience in training medical professionals.

2. Promotion and preparation of participants for individual testing and evaluation of the e-learning course

The responsible partners in each country have to promote the piloting of the course and recruit participants through direct contacts using the Stakeholders list, contacts with nurses' associations, agencies for recruiting nurses for work abroad, hospitals, companies, providing homecare, language

training centres providing training to medical professionals etc., as well as using social media. In the promotion campaign brief information about the project and the e-learning course should be provided.

The preparation of participants for the individual work with the course could be carried out either by organizing piloting workshops or by providing instructions by e-mail or Skype. Partners should decide which option is most appropriate for the particular conditions in their country.

2.1. Organization and conducting of the piloting workshops (E1 – E6)

If partners decide to organise and conduct the workshops before the individual testing, in the promotion campaign they should provide event's programme together with the brief information about the project and the e-learning course.

In this case the objective of these events is to present the e-learning course to nurses, working in the partner countries and to trainers in the three languages (French, Italian and Dutch), to provide guidelines for work with the e-learning system and the pilot testing and evaluation process, as well as to collect information about participants' first impressions and reactions to the course design and content.

The workshops will be a half day events. The partners are free to decide whether morning or afternoon session is appropriate for the conducting the events. Example of the programme is provided in Annex 1.

During the workshop all necessary conditions and atmosphere should be ensured so that the participants understand clearly their tasks in the pilot testing and evaluation and how to work with the e-learning system, as well as to be motivated to work individually with it after the workshop.

At the end of the workshop all participants will have fill in an evaluation questionnaire about the event (Annex 2). The partner's expert conducting the workshop will have to summarise the participants' reactions and opinions shared, as well as questions asked, according a template provided in Annex 3.

It is recommendable to distribute the evaluation questionnaires (Annexes 4 and 5) that the participants will have to fill in after the individual work with the e-learning course in order to know on what issues they have to focus during the piloting.

It is necessary at the end of the workshop the partner's expert to make a list of the course units that will be tested by each of the nurses, so that all units of the course, irrespectively of the language, be piloted in each country. Also equal distribution of participants and units tested should be ensured. It is recommended that the language trainers go through the entire course in the respective language in order to provide expert opinion with respect to content and methodology complementing the opinion of the end users.

2.2. Providing instructions by e-mail, individual meetings and/or Skype

The objective in this case is also to provide to already recruited participants (nurses, working in the partner countries and to trainers in the three languages) information about the e-learning course, guidelines for work with the e-learning system and the pilot testing and evaluation process.

The experts from partner organisations, responsible for this task, should make a list of the course units that will be tested by each of the nurses, so that all units of the course, irrespectively of the language, be piloted in each country. It is recommended that the language trainers go through the entire course in the respective language in order to provide expert opinion with respect to content and methodology complementing the opinion of the end users.

As pointed out in the previous item, it is recommendable to distribute the evaluation questionnaires that the participants will have to fill in after the individual work with the e-learning course in order to know on what issues they have to focus during the piloting.

3. Individual testing and evaluation of the e-learning course

The nurses involved will have to pass through at least 2 units of the e-learning course. The language trainers in French, Italian and/or Dutch should review the entire course in the respective language.

The partner responsible for pilot testing and evaluation in each country should appoint appropriate expert, project team member, whom the participants may contact by phone and e-mail, if they have questions, difficulties etc. and need support.

The partners that selected the second option for preparation of the participants for the individual work of the course (item 2.2.) could organise and conduct the piloting workshop during the period for individual testing and evaluation. The objective in this case is to provide support and clarification of participants' questions. So, the partners should decide what is the appropriate time for the workshop provision and design the programme of the event, according to the identified needs of participants.

At the end of the testing period all participants have to fill in the evaluation questionnaires. They will be available online, but partners are free to administer them by e-mail, too. The paper version is not recommended because it will take more time to process the results.

All participants will receive a certificate for participation in the piloting and evaluation of the e-learning course for workplace language and communication for nurses, signed by the partner organisation that organised the piloting in the respective country.

4. Reporting on pilot testing and evaluation of the e-learning course (15.09.2018)

Every partner should prepare a report on the results from the pilot implementation of the e-learning course according a common template (Annex 6). Based on the national reports and overall report summarising the results obtained will be elaborated by ITPIO.
